Pursuant to RCW 4.64.030, Petitioner Jarrod Sierocki, by and through his attorney of record, attests to the following judgment summary in support of his request to have an Australian judgment recognized in King County Superior Court of the State of Washington.

Judgement Creditor:

Jarrod Sierocki is the judgement creditor in this action and an Australian citizen. He is represented by attorney Ryan Solomons in Brisbane, Queensland, Australia. In addition, Mr. Sierocki is also represented by attorney George A. Mix, WSBA No. 32864.

Judgment Debtor:

Paul Grant Klerck is the judgment debtor and an Australian citizen. His representative's last known address is David Mansfield of Deloitte, at the Eclipse Tower, 60 Station Street, Parramatta, New South Wales, 2150 (Australia).

1 **Date of Filing of Judgment:**

2 On April 17, 2015, Mr. Sierocki obtained a judgment against Mr. Klerck and several
3 other defendants.

4 **Expiration Date:**

5 The time to appeal the above judgment in the State of Queensland has expired. Upon
6 information and belief, there is no time limit for executing on a judgment in Australia,
7 however, a creditor has 15 years to take action on a judgment debt.

8 **Place of Entry:**

9 The judgement was entered in the State of Queensland, Australia, by the Supreme Court
10 of Queensland.

11 **Substance of Judgment:**

12 This lawsuit arose after Paul Klerck engaged in defamatory and harassing conduct against
13 Jarrod Sierocki both in person and via the Internet. Mr. Sierocki obtained a judgment against
14 Mr. Klerck and others for the abovementioned misconduct in Queensland, Australia. The
15 judgment awarded the following monetary damages:



 - \$80,000 plus interest in the amount of \$11,627.20; both to be paid by Mr. Klerck to Mr.
17 Sierocki

18 In addition, the court permanently restrained Mr. Klerck, by himself and/or his servants
19 or agents, from publishing or causing to be published defamatory statements and materials
20 about Mr. Sierocki and his business.

21 Critically, Mr. Sierocki is not seeing recognition in Pierce County Superior Court of the
22 above-mentioned monetary fines assessed against Mr. Klerck. Mr. Sierocki instead seeks
23 recognition only of the injunctive relief provided by the Supreme Court of Queensland.
